

# ForestBond 2017

PE 2011 Inc. ("PE 2011") is a Delaware-based company offering interests in 100 hectares (250 acres) of mixed tropical timber plantations and cash crops in Panama. These cultivations are established and managed through Planting Empowerment's Equitable Forestry model to produce competitive investment returns while reducing the political and project risks associated with agroforestry investments. Accredited investors have the opportunity to participate in PE 2011 through a debt issuance called the ForestBond 2017.

## Projected Return

An interest rate of 7% is offered on the ForestBond 2017 when purchased at \$150,000

## Term Length of Bond

5 years - matures 5 years after issuance

## Minimum Investment

\$150,000 - 5 units for a total of \$750,000 are available

## Eligible Investors

Accredited investors as [defined by the SEC](#)

## Distributions

ForestBond 2017 holders will not receive distributions before 2017. If Planting Empowerment is not able to repay the full face value of ForestBond 2017, holders will have first rights to any cash available for distribution from timber sales or any other revenue generated from the plantations. This revenue may be from timber sales, seed sales, carbon credit sales, or any other revenue associated with PE 2011. Potential cacao revenue from cacao intercropped with the trees of the PE 2011 plantation would not be available to ForestBond 2017 holders.

## Liquidity

Investors should expect to hold the Bond until full maturity, or five years. Currently, there is no current secondary market for ForestBond 2017, but it may be possible to sell a ForestBond 2017 to a third party through the [Mission Markets platform](#).

## Taxes

Each investor or entity will be responsible for any US income taxes on any of their profits.
